Lvming Waterfalls

The biggest waterfalls in the Upper Subansiri district of Arunachal Pradesh - Lvming Dingdo waterfalls is a sight to behold. Just 8km before entering Nacho, this site of immense scenic beauty tumbles down from a height of 15 feet and is easily accessible from the main road that connects Daporijo with Nacho. The dense wild forest cover on the road adds to its overall appeal.
